

Corona traffic light warning system at the FH Campus Wien

The traffic light warning system at the FH Campus Wien is based on the traffic light warning system of the Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research. The nationwide traffic light color for universities or the traffic light color for the FH Campus Wien may differ from the regional status of the federal traffic light warning system.
