Socio-therapeutic work focuses on consultation and treatment with and from biopsychosocial needs. The focus is on socially induced risk factors such as poverty or social discrimination. Social therapy is a science-based psychosocial practice of Clinical Social Work. One goal is the inclusion of people under extreme pressure in their everyday life.

As an expert in socio-therapeutic work, you will advise people in complex life situations and work in multiprofessional, interdisciplinary teams together with professionals in the medical, pedagogical, psychological and psychotherapeutic fields. You will work in non-stationary, stationary and semi-stationary areas and will be able to recognize and process complex interaction or communication dynamics.
